The Auto Industry in India in financial year 2018-19 witnessed a production of 30 million vehicles in which 2/3 wheelers - one of the major segments of the auto industry contributed to 25 million, Passenger cars 4 million and Commercial Vehicles 1 million. In 2019-20, the auto Industry has witnessed a degrowth, adversely hampering the production across all segments & the reasons contributing to this have been the liquidity crunch and weakening economic arowth.

The Industry in 2020 is also gearing up to comply with BS 6 emission norms from April 2020, an upgrade from the present BS 4 norms and vehicles not complying to these norms shall not be allowed to sell as per the Regulations issued by the Govt of India. While transition to BS 6 is a welcome move given that it ensures cleaner mobility. however the process involved is time consuming as well as costly as technology upgrade is required across all the segments.

The Govt is also urging the industry to gradually shift towards Electric vehicles. We are already seeing the changeover from IC engines to Electric in the buses being run in metro cities. The Govt has also announced 100% shift to EV for 3 wheelers by 2025 and phase wise shift in the 2-wheeler / Passenger cars segment. The challenge is immense to create the battery charging infrastructure and for the vehicle manufacturers to shift to this. In conclusion the Auto Industry is in the process of transformation to cater to a cleaner environment.
